Puppy Puppet



You will need:

- Toilet paper rolls
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole punch
- Drinking straws
- String
- Paddle pop sticks
- Pencils
- Textas, stamps, stickers etc.

Puppy Puppet

- 1. Colour-in/decorate the toilet paper rolls. Cut one roll in half; one half will be for the head and the other half for the ears.
- 2. Punch a hole at one end of the head and another underneath.
- 3. Cut the ears, a single elongated 8-shape out of the paper roll, and glue them to the top of the head (near the hole). Push in the cardboard where the ears are glued, creating an indent on the head to make the ears stick up.
- 4. Glue two paddle pop sticks together to form a cross; set aside.
- 5. Punch four holes on the bottom of the body for the legs. Thread two 15cm pieces of string through the leg holes, adding cut drinking straw pieces for the feet. Knot at each end.
- 6. On the opposite side of the paper roll, punch holes at both ends of the body. Thread a long piece of string (approx. 60cm) through the body and head. Tie it to the popsicle stick-cross.
- 7. Glue on a cut drinking straw to create a tail and draw/stick on eyes.
