Pinwheel

- Scissors
- Fasteners (pin)
- Coloured paper / white paper cardboard
- Drinking straws
- Pencils, stamps, stickers etc.
- 1. Trim the piece of paper or card until it is a square, with sides equal to the width of the page.
- 2. Colour one side and then the other decorate any way you like.
- 3. Fold the square in half diagonally, each way, so that you have two diagonal folds which cross in the centre of the page.
- 4. Cut along the folds, but stop at least 3cm from the centre, as shown by the dotted lines in the diagram. The page should now look like 4 triangles joined at the centre.
- 5. Take one corner of each triangle and fold it over until the point is on the centre of the square. Each corner should overlap the one underneath slightly.
- 6. Now prick the pin through all four points and through the centre of the page and stick it into the blunt end of a straw.
- 7. Wave it in the air or blow on it, to get the sails to rotate. Loosen the pin slightly if necessary to allow the sails to turn more freely.
